Fourth of July Promo



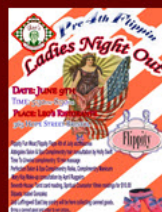

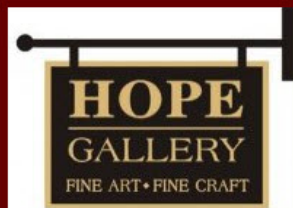


"Mistero on Hope Street"

Artist of the Month



Johan Bjurman is a self-taught artist born in Providence, Rhode Island in 1947. Experience as an artist was gained in an apprenticeship with scenic and pictorial artists in the outdoor advertising industry. He further enhanced his education in the fine arts by traveling in Europe and also by a close association and study with many local artists.

Johan, 62, was born and raised in North Providence, RI and now lives in Johnston, RI. He does everything from historical restorations (Donis Duke's Shangri La in Hawaii) inside buildings and trompe l'oeil, which creates the illusion of being three dimensional, to huge murals six to eight stories high on the outside of buildings and "The Fight at Kuhn's Brickyard" an 12-by-80 foot mural of a battlefield in Gettysburg, PA just to name a few. The historical restoration around the country has been done with John Canning Painting and Restoration Company - many of the state capital buildings and public buildings in Washington, D.C. including the Vice President's Office. Those familiar with Rhode Island have probably seen his work - including a giant mural on the Hanley Building in Providence, which is made to look as though the building has been peeled open. Johan has exhibited his traditional paintings in galleries throughout the state. He said he's even worked on the sets of several major movies made in the state of Rhode Island in the past 20 years.
